

Stuttgart 2024-2025 Influenza Campaign

MTF Influenza Vaccine Eligibility:

- 1. Participating individuals need to be registered with MHS Genesis. This will allow the MTF to document the vaccine in accordance with DHA.
 - a. To register, please visit the clinic Patient Administration office 0800-1200 Monday- Friday.
- 2. Completion of the Influenza Screening Form, DHA 116 v AUG 2024, for each individual receiving the vaccine. The influenza vaccine is recommended for everyone 6 months and older.

Good to Know:

- 1. MTF influenza vaccine will only be provided during the scheduled events, no walk-ins will be accepted.
- 2. Youths 15-17 years of age may receive the flu vaccine without a parent/guardian present. They will need their DoD ID, and meet eligibility criteria listed above. Screening will be done by a provider.
- 3. Influenza vaccines will only be offered during the scheduled events listed. DODEA schedule-friendly events are highlighted in green.
- 4. The influenza vaccine is a requirement for military personnel, DODEA, and CYS.
 - a. Please refer to each individual organization for their deadline.
- 5. New Panzer location. BLDG 2918 is located behind USO building.
- 6. Vaccines are not fun, we encourage families to bring a "special" band-aid, comfort item and/or treat for your little one(s).



Situation

On average, the snowy period of the year lasts for 2.1 months, from November 27 to January 30, with a sliding 31-day snowfall of at least 1.0 inches. The month with the most snow in Stuttgart is December, with an average snowfall of 1.7 inches. The snowless period of the year lasts for 9.9 months, from January 30 to November 27.




